I have been made aware of your recent request for the services of a Licensed Public Adjuster to assist you with your insurance claim pertaining to the recent hailstorms. 
At the inception of our Hurricane Dolly loss, EEISD was unable to come to an agreement with our insurance company on the extent of the damages and subsequent monetary value of these damages. Typical to insurance claims within the Rio Grand Valley, the insurance company labeled our damages as pre-existing, and therefore excluded a large percent of the damages. As a result of our disagreement, we entered into a formal insurance appraisal and nominated Scott M. Favre Public Adjuster LLC, through the recommendation of our Attorney, as our appraiser.

From the commencement of their involvement, Scott M. Favre Public Adjuster LLC was able to successfully argue our loss, and as a direct result of their involvement, increase our insurance recovery substantially. Not only did Mr. Favre successfully argue our loss specific to our insurance policy language, his detailed knowledge of the construction of our buildings and the specific requirements needed to ensure a proper build-back was instrumental in convincing the appraisal panel to rule in our favor. It is very untypical to have a public adjuster that is versed equally in the understanding of insurance policies and construction. With this ability, Mr. Favre was able to correlate the building damages to Hurricane Dolly and accurately estimate the repairs of these damages in accordance to the current building codes and accepted construction standards.

To complicate matters, during this time, EEISD was also involved in construction defects litigation against numerous contractors. It was vital to the success of our insurance claim that our representative be able to understand and distinguish the differences between these types of damages. Without his specific knowledge, we would not have been able to isolate the storm damages, and therefore would have had to forfeit on a large amount of insurance proceeds that were owed to us.
